MATERIALS

Yarn provided, crochet hook size:- 3.0mm

ABBREVIATIONS

MR - Magic Ring

Rnd - Round

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

htr - half treble crochet

tr - treble crochet

dbtr - double treble crochet

dec - decrease (2 dc together)

inc - increase (2 dc in the same stitch)

sts - stitches

sl st - slip stitch

Please note:

If you don't want to work into a Magic Ring, chain the equivalent number of stitches and join to the first chain with a slip stitch, you can then work your double crochet into the chain stitches.

INSTRUCTIONS

CABIN

Using a stitch marker to indicate the beginning of each row, and with the yellow yarn, work in rounds as follows:

Rnd 1: 1 ch, 6 dc in a MR (6 sts);

Rnd 2: 1 inc x6 (12 sts);

Rnd 3: (1 inc, 1dc) x6 (18 sts);

Rnd 4: (2 dc, 1 inc) x6 (24 sts);

Rnd 5: (1 inc, 3 dc) x6 (30 sts);

Rnd 6: 2 dc, 1 inc, (4 dc, 1 inc) x5, 2 dc (36 sts);

Rnd 7: 4 dc, 1 inc, (5 dc, 1 inc) x5, 1 dc (42 sts);

Rnd 8: (6 dc, 1 inc) x6 (48) sts;

Rnd 9: (1 inc, 7 dc) x6 (54) sts;

Rnd 10: 2 dc, 1 inc, (8 dc, 1 inc) x5, 6 dc (60 sts);

Rnd 11: 4 dc, 1 inc, (9 dc, 1 inc) x5, 5 dc (66 sts);

Rnd 12: 6 dc, 1 inc, 4 dc, fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.



COCKPIT

With the black yarn ch2:

Row 1: 2 dc in the second chain from hook, ch1, turn (2sts);

Row 2: 2 inc, ch1, turn (4 sts);

Row 3: (1 dc, 1 inc) x 2, ch 1, turn (6 sts);

Row 4: (2 dc, 1 inc) x 2, ch 1, turn (8 sts);

Row 5: (3 dc, 1 inc) x 2, ch 1, turn (10 sts);

Row 6: 10 dc, ch1, turn (10 sts);

Row 7: (1 dc, 1 inc) x 2, 2 dc, (1 inc, 1 dc) x 2, ch 1, turn (14 sts);

Row 8: 14 dc (14 sts), fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.



TAIL

With the yellow yarn ch 11:

Row 1: Dc in the second ch from hook, dc in each ch across, ch 1, turn (10 sts)

Rows 2-3: 10 dc, ch 1, turn (10 sts);

Row 4: 1 dec, 6 dc, 1 dec, ch 1, turn (8 sts);

Rows 5-6: 8 dc, ch 1, turn (8 sts);

Row 7: 1 dec, 4 dc, 1 dec, ch 1, turn (6 sts);

Rows 8-9: 6 dc, ch 1, turn (6 sts);

Row 10: 4 dc, 1 dec, ch 1, turn (5 sts);

Rows 11-12: 5 dc, ch 1, turn (5 sts);

Row 13: 1 dec, 3 dc, ch 5, turn (4 sts + ch 5);

Row 14: Dc in the second ch from hook, dc to end (8 sts);

Row 15: 8 dc, ch 1, turn (8 sts);

Row 16: 6 dc, 1 dec (7 sts) fasten off and weave in the ends.



TAIL ROTOR

With the yellow yarn work as follows:

Rnd 1: 1 ch, 5 dc in a MR (5 sts)
Sl st to first dc, fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Change to black and work as follows:

Rnd 2: Join with a sl st to top of any dc and ch 4, (1 dbtr, ch 4, 1 sl st) in the same st, (1 sl st, ch 4, 1 dbtr, ch 4, 1 sl st) in next st x4, sl st to first ch 4, fasten off and weave in ends.



MAIN ROTOR

With the black yarn work as follows:

Rnd 1: 1 ch, 6 dc in a MR (6 sts);
Rnd 2: 1 inc x6 (12 sts), sl st to first dc, fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.



BLADES OF MAIN ROTOR

With the black yarn ch14:

Row 1: 1 dc in second ch from hook, 1 htr, 5 tr, 4 htr, 2 dc (13 sts), fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

You will need to make 3 more blades.
With the black yarn ch 2:-

Row 1: 2 dc in the second ch from hook, ch 1, turn (2 sts);

Row 2: 2 inc, ch 1, turn (4 sts);

Row 3: (1 dc, 1 inc) x2, ch 1, turn (6 sts);

Row 4: (2 dc, 1 inc) x2, ch 1, turn (8 sts);

Row 5: (3 dc, 1 inc) x2, ch 1, turn (10 sts);

Row 6: 10 dc, ch 1, turn (10 sts);

Row 7: (1 dc, 1 inc) x2, 2 dc, (1 inc, 1 dc) x2, ch 1, turn (14 sts);

Row 8: 14 dc (14 sts), fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.



LANDING SKID

With the black yarn ch 28 for the bottom of the skid:

Row 1: 1 dc in the second ch from hook, 3 dc, 1 dec, 2 dec, ch 5 for first post, 1 dc in second ch from hook, 3 dc along post, 11 dc along bottom of skid, ch 5 for second post, 1 dc in second ch from hook, 3 dc along post, 2 dc, 1 dec, 4 dc along skid, fasten off and weave in ends.



TO ASSEMBLE

Refer to the picture for the layout of your helicopter, then sew the Tail Rotor to the Tail, the Tail and Landing Skid under the Cabin, onto the Cabin sew the Cockpit, the Blades and the Main Rotor. Finally long stitch the red Heartbeat lines and sew in any loose ends.
